## Call for Editor Community College Review

<u>Community College Review</u> is published by SAGE in association with North Carolina State University Department of Educational Leadership, Policy, and Human Development.

Professor Jamie Lester will be completing her tenure as Editor of the *Community College Review* (CCR) in June 2020, and North Carolina State University's Department of Educational Leadership, Policy, and Human Development and SAGE Publications announce the call for Editor. For more than 45 years the CCR has published scholarship from a wide variety of theoretical, practical, and disciplinary perspectives related to community colleges. CCR has published manuscripts dealing with all aspects of community college administration, education, and policy within both the

Candidates should possess a doctoral degree in a relevant field and demonstrate a broad knowledge of community colleges with a record of significant research in the area and engagement in professional organizations related to community colleges.

- 1. Applicants should develop a letter that addresses the following (no more than 6 single spaced pages total):
  - Brief introduction of the candidate and why she/he is seeking the position.
  - Vision for CCR.
  - Publishing and editing experience with journals.
  - Home institutional support, financial or otherwise (space, release time, etc.), to aid in work with the journal.
  - Plan for engagement of journal reviewers, editorial board members, and Associate Editors.
